## ELECTRIC FORKLIFTS

Electric forklifts offer lower operating and maintenance costs than diesel or propane and offer improved health and safety conditions, particularly with indoor use.

### Rebates

Rebates are available for conversion, new construction, fleet retention and refurbished fleet additions operating at least 40 hours per week.\*

### Financing

Businesses purchasing an electric forklift within ECE's service territory may be eligible for a loan from ECE's Revolving Loan Fund.\*

### Benefits of electric forklifts

1. **Fuel** - 40 cents of electricity performs the same as \$1.50 of propane.
2. **Maintenance** - Electric forklifts cost up to 40% less to maintain.
3. **Operations** - Reduce labor costs with no tanks or batteries to change.
4. **Air Quality** - Electric forklifts produce zero emissions during operation.

### Eligible Forklift Equipment

1. Class 1 electric indoor or outdoor forklifts
  - 36V, 48V or 80V
  - 3,000 to 12,000-pound lift capacity
2. Class 2 indoor narrow-aisle forklifts
  - 24V, 36V or 48V
  - 3,000 to 5,000-pound lift capacity
